<ul> <li>Members were informed that a National workshop on "Enhancing Understanding &amp; Implementation of the International Treaty on Plant Genetic Resources for Food and Agriculture (ITPGRFA) in India" was organized by PPV&amp;FRA on 17-18 November, 2014 at Deendayal Research Institute, Chitrakoot, Madhya Pradesh. This workshop was jointly organized by Protection of Plant Varieties and Farmers' Rights Authority; Department of Agriculture and Co-operation, Govt. of India; ICAR-National Bureau of Plant Genetic Resources; Zonal Project Director-Zone–VII, Regional office of FAO for Asia and Pacific, Bangkok and Deendayal Research Institute, Chitrakoot. It was further informed that during the workshop, a national exhibition and awareness programme about the PPV&amp;FR Act and ITPGRFA was also arranged showcasing seeds, planting material and the fresh agro-products of the farmers' varieties, traditional varieties, landraces, folk varieties conserved and preserved by farmers, NGOs and some of the Krishi Vigyan Kendras (KVKs), State Agricultural Universities (SAUs) etc. as side event during the above period at DRI, Chitrakoot.</li> </ul>

S.O. – In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 35 of the Protection of Plant Varieties and Farmers' Rights Act, 2001 (53 of 2001), the Protection Plant Varieties and Farmers' Rights Authority with the prior approval of the Central Government hereby makes the following further amendment in the notification published in the Gazette of India, Extraordinary, Part II, Section 3, Sub-section (ii), vide S.O. 2182 (E) dated 26<sup>th</sup> August, 2009 namely:-

- In para-1of the said notification, for the words "0.2 % of the sales value" the words "0.5 % of gross profit" shall be substituted.
- 2. In sub-para (b) of para 2 of the said notification for the words "0.1 % of the sales value" the words "0.25 % of gross profit" shall be substituted.

- c) After initial period of registration (six years in case of field crops and nine years in case of trees and vines) renewal fee must also be paid in one sum for the remaining period or for a shorter period as chosen by the registered breeder.
- d) Non-payment of renewal fee would lead to forfeiture of registration
