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In order to provide for the establishment of an effective system for Protection of Plant Varieties and Farmers' Rights, Government of India has enacted a legislation viz., Protection of Plant Varieties and Farmers' Rights Act, 2001 (53 of 2001). Protection of Plant Varieties and Farmers' Rights Authority (PPV&FRA) has been established for the purpose of this Act.

The PPV&FRA needs services of one Senior Technical Officer on contract basis for a period of six months on a consolidated emolument of Rs. 20000/- per months. No other allowances such as DA, HRA, CCA etc. will be admissible. For this purpose a walk-in interview will be held in the Office of the PPV&FRA on 10th October, 2011 at 3:00 PM.

The essential educational and other qualifications required for the post are as follows:-

1. Essential: (i) Post-Graduate Degree in Agricultural Science from a recognized University with specialization in Plant Breeding & Genetics/ Plant Genetic Resources/ Seed Technology/ Biotechnology/ Agricultural Botany/Agronomy/Horticulture/Forestry.
(ii) Minimum three year experience in Seed Development Programme and Plant Varietal improvement activities/Breeding/ Plant Genetic resources /Biotechnology in a research institute/reputed organization.
2. Desirable: Ph.D. in any of the above subject with research experience in Seed Development Programme/ Intellectual Property Rights and Plant Varietal Improvement activities in a research institute/reputed organization.
3. Age not exceeding 30 years.
Relaxation for SC/ST/OBC/PH as per the Government of India instruction.

The eligible and interested candidates may appear for a walk-in interview on 10th October, 2011 at 3:00 PM along with their testimonials, age proof etc. in the office located at address given above. The candidate should reach the office premises at least one hour in advance of the time of interview. No TA/DA for attending the walk-in interview will be admissible.
