## Guidelines for conducting training cum farmers awareness programme.

**Venue:** Venue for conducting the programme shall be selected as a central place where maximum participants can participate without much expenditure on travelling cost in consultation with PPV&FRA.

- The Farmers participants: the Farmers those are engaged in conservation of Agro-biodiversity and development of new variety by way of selection and preservation of traditional varieties may be invited.
- 2. Famers may be requested to bring the samples of the traditional varieties preserved by them and small exhibition may be arranged during the programme.
- Participants from various stakeholders may be invited such as officers of the Agriculture & Horticultural Department, Biodiversity management Committees, SAUs and other officials engaged in agricultural activities.
- 4. Resource material may be prepared by using materials available on Authority website. Preferably in local language.
- Resource persons may be invited for delivering lecture on PPV & FR Act, 2001 and about the activities of the Authority giving more emphasis on provisions of Farmers' Rights.
- 6. Sufficient time may be given for the interaction with the farmers about the provisions on Farmers' Rights and filling of the application etc.
- 7. Duly filled application for Registration of Farmers' Varieties may be collected before end of the training programme.
- 8. On completion of the Training Programme reports along with good photographs and Utilization Certificate must be submitted to the PPV & FR Authority office at the earliest.
- KVKs submitting maximum number of application for registration of farmers' Variety will be recognized suitably by the Authority.
